



International Coalition of Sites of Conscience Internships



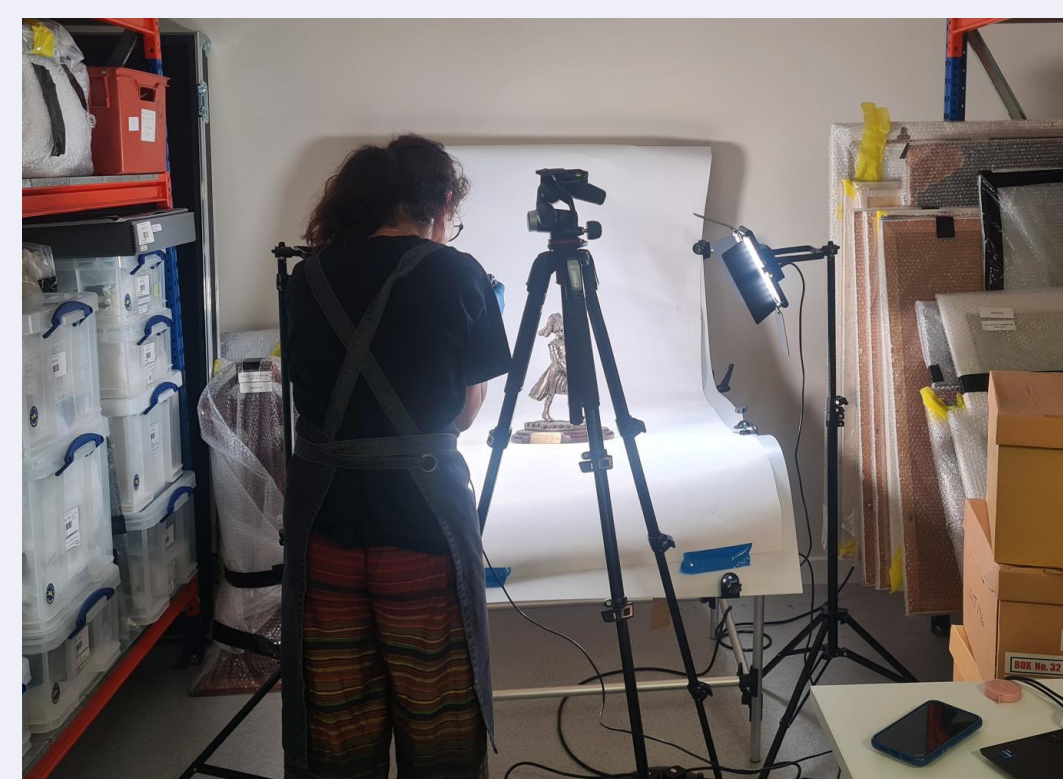
The International Coalition of Sites of Conscience (ICSC) is a collaboration between Newcastle University and ICSC, a global network of historic sites, museums and memory initiatives centred around human rights and social justice (Sites of Conscience).

Internships are either virtual or in-person and are open to current students on undergraduate and postgraduate (PhD, research & taught). Last year, the partnership sponsored 12 in-person internships and 5 virtual internships.



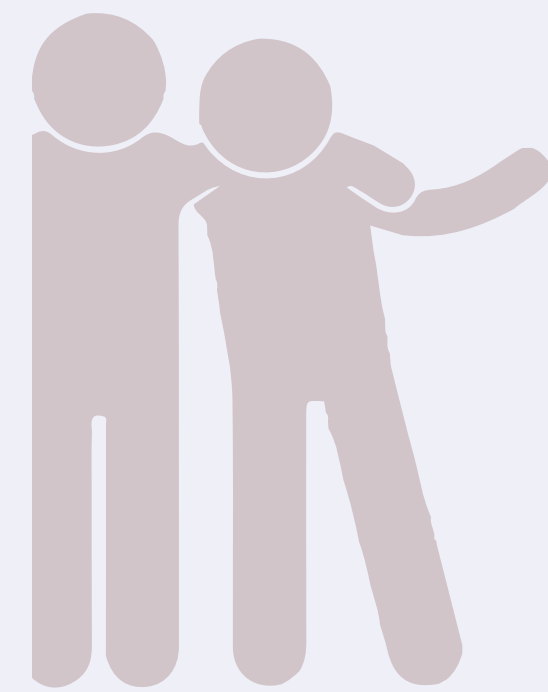

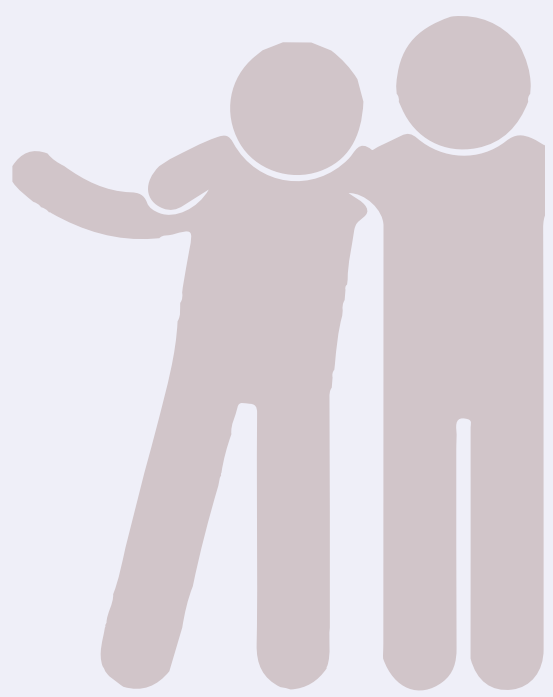


WAR CHILDHOOD MUSEUM

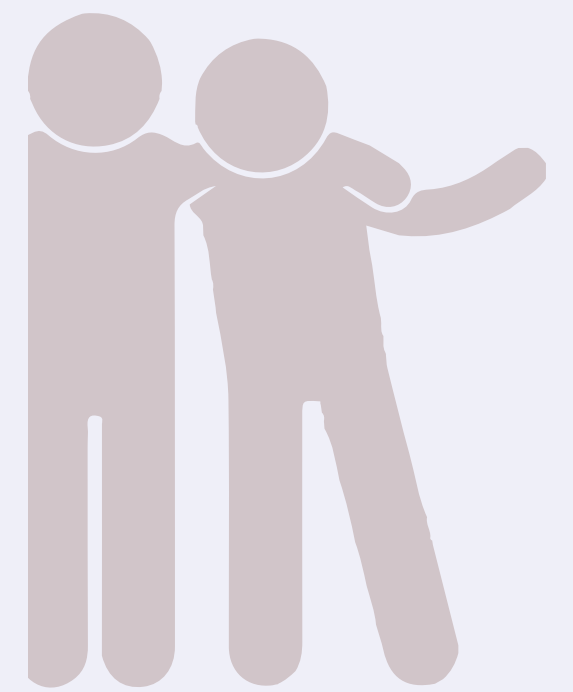
The War Childhood Museum (WCM) is an independent, youth-led, human-centered museum dedicated exclusively to childhoods affected by armed conflicts.

YOUTH INITIATIVE FOR HUMAN RIGHTS

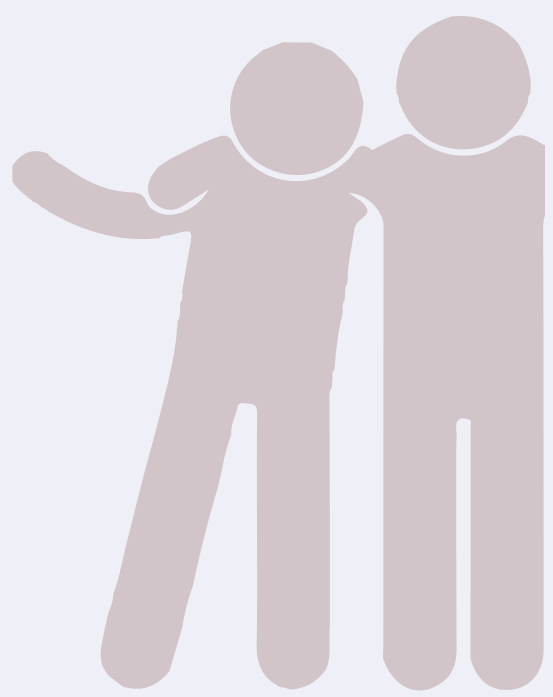
